ABOUT THE

The ampersand (&) is more than a symbol—it represents the moment when our obedience meets God's rumbling. Rumbles are when God stirs beneath the surface, awakening His people and calling us forward. Echoes are the legacies of our lives, the things we repeat and reflect into the world. On their own, echoes can fade or chase after lesser things—but when God stirs and we respond, His power resounds "to all generations, forever and ever. Amen" (Ephesians 3:20-21). The ampersand reminds us that this is the intersection where heaven's stirring and our obedience create an echo that carries God's glory into the future.

DEAR RESTORE FAMILY,

From the beginning, Restore has been a story of God's power at work. In 2016, a handful of people gathered in a living room to pray and dream about what God might do in Jacksonville. We believed then—and we still believe today—that "to Him who is able to do above and beyond all that we ask or think...to Him be the glory...to all generations, forever and ever. Amen." (Ephesians 3:20–21).

Since those prayers, God has written an incredible story. We've seen lives changed, families restored, and celebrated nearly 200 baptisms into Christ. Our Sunday gatherings have quadrupled, and through Reckless Love Sundays we've served our city with thousands of hours. Most importantly, the echo of God's goodness is being heard in every generation.

Now we stand at another pivotal moment. God is stirring again—rumbling under the surface—and calling us to echo His work into the future. Rumbles & Echoes is more than a fundraising initiative; it is a declaration that we are preparing ourselves for investing in missions, renovating ministry space, and reducing debt.

HERE IS OUR INVITATION: as one church family, let's step boldly into this moment, trusting God to do more than we can ask or imagine, and echo His love so loudly that generations to come will still hear it.




GROWTH

When Restore first opened its doors in 2017, a small group of people dreamed of what God might do in Jacksonville. None of us could have imagined what He actually had in store. In just a few years, Restore has quadrupled in size. Before moving into our downtown building, an average Sunday meant around 110 people gathered to worship. Now, that number is closer to 440—and it continues to climb. These aren't numbers on a chart. Every person represents a story: a marriage restored, a single parent finding hope, a new believer discovering Jesus, families finding community, young Marines encountering Jesus, children discovering faith that will shape their future. What we see on this page is more than rapid growth—it's God doing "above and beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us."



BAPTISMS

Nothing tells the story of Restore like the waters of baptism. Before moving into our current building, we had celebrated nearly 100 baptisms in our short history. In the twenty months since moving in, we have already passed that number again. Today, nearly 200 people have publicly declared Jesus as Lord and Savior through baptism. Each wave of baptism tells of a new life, a family transformed, and the echo of God's grace reaching into generations. Baptism is more than a milestone—it's the echo of resurrection in every generation. And what we see here is not the result of our planning but of God's Spirit at work, transforming lives. It's living proof that He is able to do immeasurably more than we could ever dream.



THE VILLAGE

If you want to see the future of the Kingdom, just peek into The Village on a Sunday morning. What began with just a couple of classrooms outlined by pipes and drapery has now grown into a bustling ministry with more than 130 kids. each week. The sounds are unmistakable—kids singing about Jesus, volunteers teaching Bible stories, little ones reciting Scripture for the first time. This is the fruit of God's work in the next generation. In just three years, The Village has quadrupled in size, and we believe it's just the beginning. We are seeing the next generation of disciple makers. What God is doing in these children is proof that His promises are for "every generation, forever and ever. Amen."






