There's a rumble stirring beneath our feet.

Not the noise of construction or the echo of voices—but something deeper. Something divine. We believe God is moving again in the story of Restore Church. And as always, He's inviting us to join Him.

But this didn't start with buildings or attendance. It started in 2016, when fifteen of us gathered in my living room, praying about a church that didn't exist yet. We believed God had something in store—that He could do more than we could ask or imagine—and we've been holding onto Ephesians 3:20–21 ever since.

"Now to him who is able to do above and beyond all that we ask or think according to the power that works in us—to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen."

On March 19, 2017, Restore held its first public service. And now, just over eight years later, we're standing in the middle of a miracle.

In the last 20 months, since moving into our building, we've baptized over 100 people—surpassing the 99 baptisms we celebrated in the years prior. Our weekly attendance has grown from 110 to over 415. We've given more than 5,000 hours to love our city through Reckless Love Sundays.



We're seeing the power of God at work. And we're seeing the obedience of His people.

That's what this season—Rumbles and Echoes—is about. It's not just about raising money. It's about raising faith. It's about being ready. Ready to move when God moves. Ready to echo His glory for generations to come.

As you read through this fact sheet, would you simply pray? Ask God how He's calling you to be part of what's next. No matter the size, your yes matters.

He is able. He is moving. And we're just getting started.

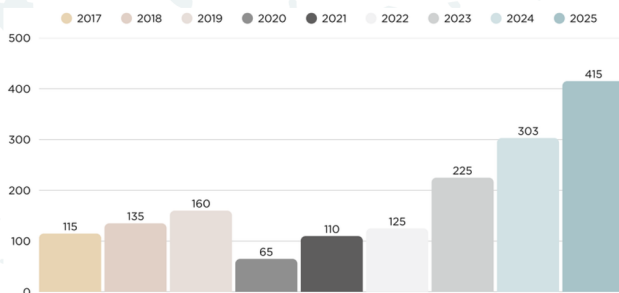

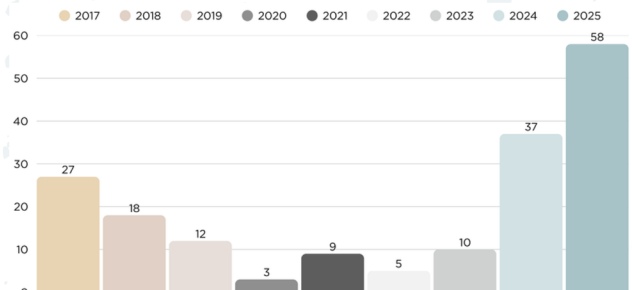
